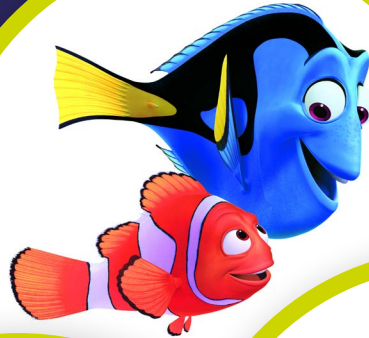

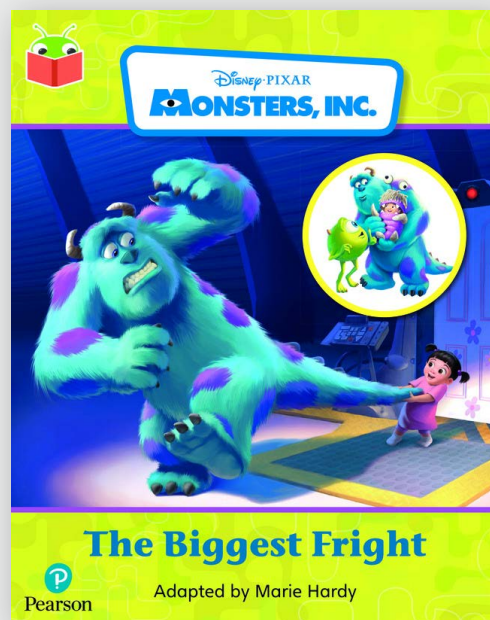

John Dougherty

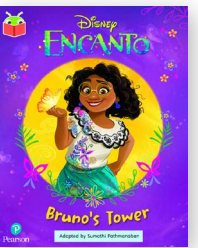

Why choose our Disney books?

What is included in the series?

- We've ensured that no child gets left behind – our Disney books have been designed to support all children as they learn to read, including those with dyslexia. The fonts are dyslexia-friendly, and the text is set on a pastel-coloured background to avoid visual stress.
- The Reception and Year 1 books are fully decodable in line with the Department for Education's Reading Framework and perfectly aligned to the Bug Club Phonics progression so you can give children even more opportunity to practise as they learn to read.
- Well-known and diverse characters to help all children feel that our books are for them whatever their ability, background or identity.

What if I am using another SSP?

We have also created Little Wandle matching packs of our Disney decodables, mapping our books to the Little Wandle progression so users of other SSPs can enjoy our diverse and engaging decodable books as well.

You can also take advantage of our Year 2 Disney books, no matter your school's SSP.

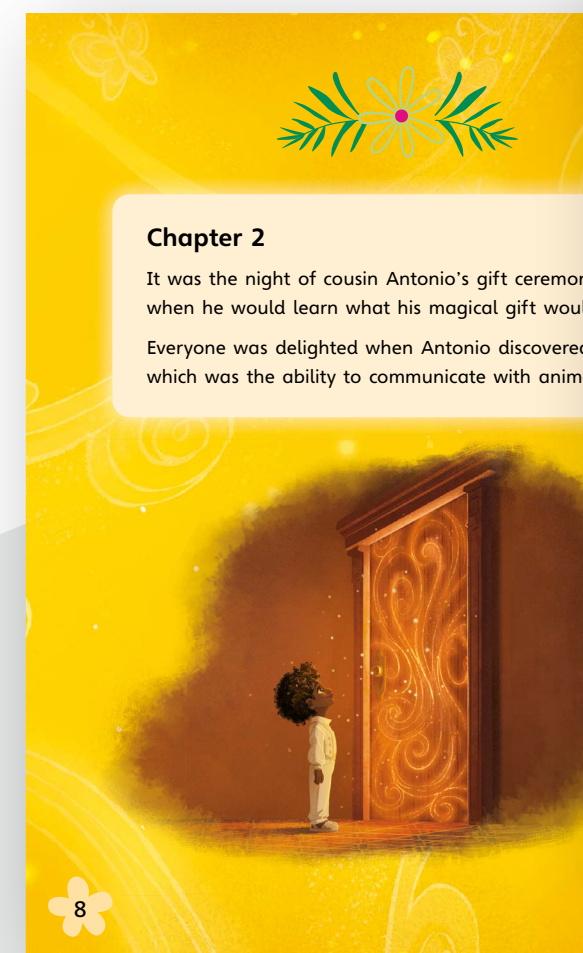
The Reading Framework states that:

Pupils must be offered a feast of books: easy reads, books about how things work, graphic novels, joke books, irreverent books, books about animals – anything that might hook them into reading – as well as the more challenging books they will listen to in story times and study in English lessons.

Importantly, they need to be offered books they might choose to read over and over again.

It has things the children are really interested in – lots of Disney films and things like that. The children are really enthused by that. We really focus on reading for pleasure and these are real reading for pleasure books.
